***DAVIS BYNUM CELEBRATES “REDS, WHITES & BLUES WITH BOWKER”
WITH FIRST PUBLIC EVENT IN BYNUM VISTA GARDEN***

HEALDSBURG, CA—Thirty-one years after opening the first winery on Westside Road, Davis Bynum will salute another Sonoma County pioneer — KRSH Radio’s Bill Bowker — who will host “Reds, Whites and Blues With Bowker” on Thursday, August 19, from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. The concert, featuring Mitch Woods and His Rocket 88’s, will be the first-ever public event held in the Bynum Vista Garden, located atop Bynum Vineyard and overlooking the picturesque Russian River Valley. The garden is featured in the August 2004 issue of *Sunset Magazine*.

Bowker is celebrating his 25th year as host of “Blues with Bowker,” which is heard on Sunday nights on KRSH 95.9 and 95.5. It is one of the longest running blues shows in the country. Bowker was named Best Radio Personality in this year’s *Bohemian* Reader’s Poll. He and business partner Doug Smith are active in the local music scene and book such events as the Sonoma County Blues Festival, Evolution of the Blues and Art in the Park Concert Series, among others.

Mitch Woods and His Rocket 88’s are Bay Area music fixtures, performing their own style of blues, jump n’boogie and swing for more than 20 years. The band has recorded five albums, including one solo by Woods.

Healdsburg Bar and Grill will offer barbeque and Davis Bynum Chardonnay and Pinot Noir will be served. The \$12 ticket price includes food and two wine tickets. Additional wine tickets will be available for purchase at the concert.
